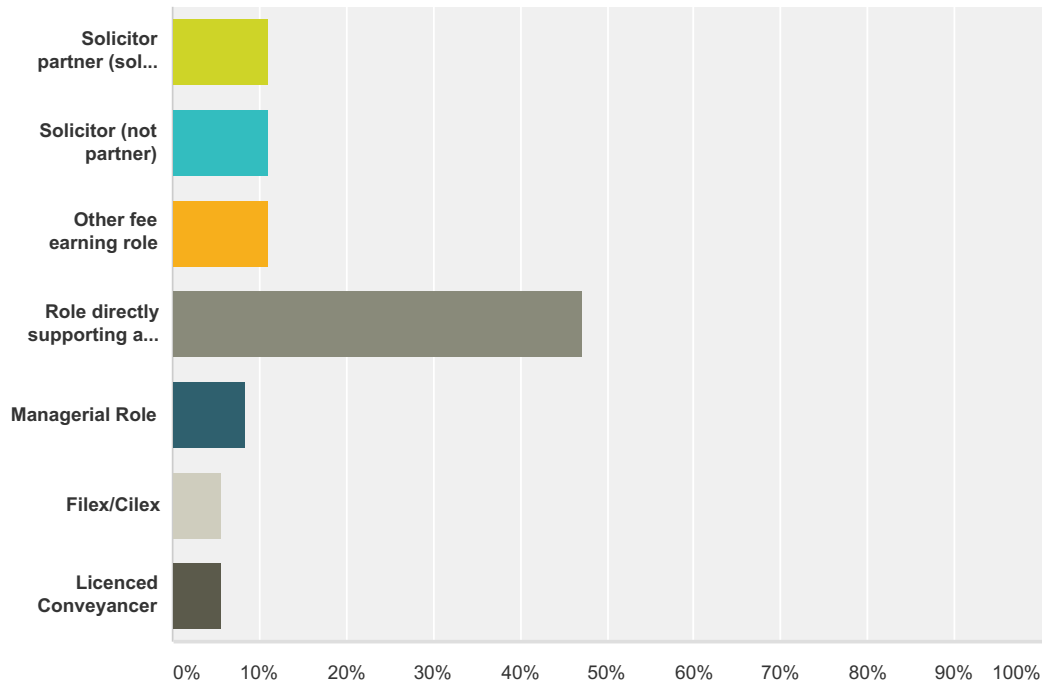


Q1 Select one category which best describes your role in the firm.

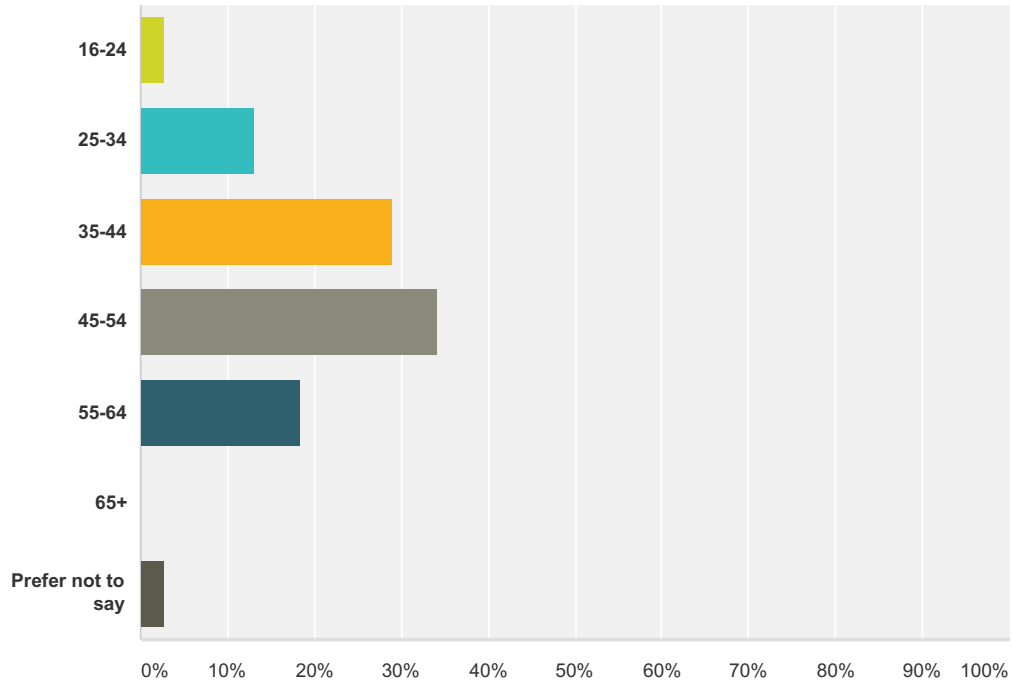

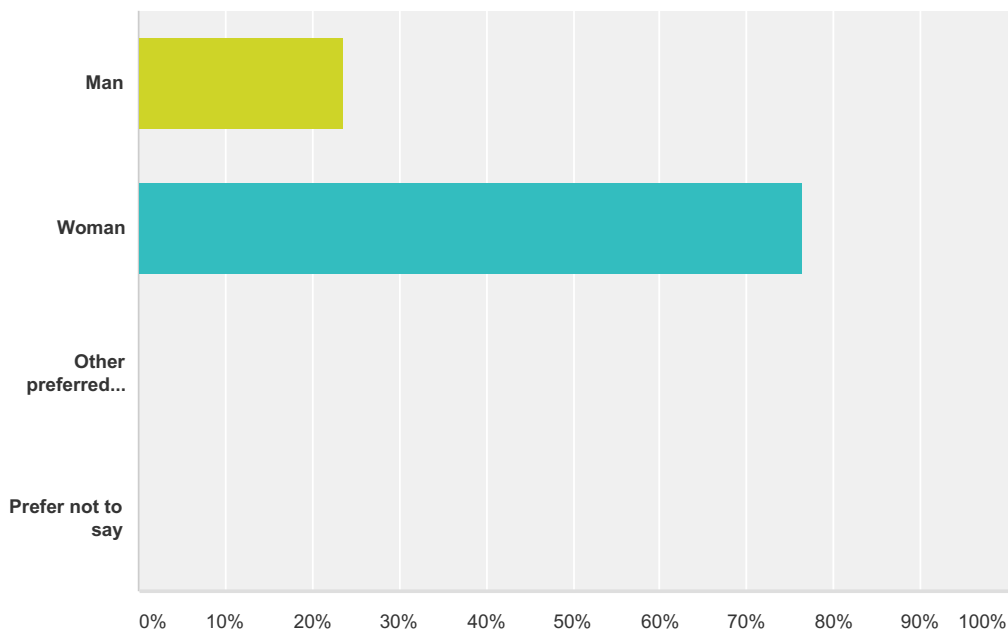

Q3 Which gender do you identify with?

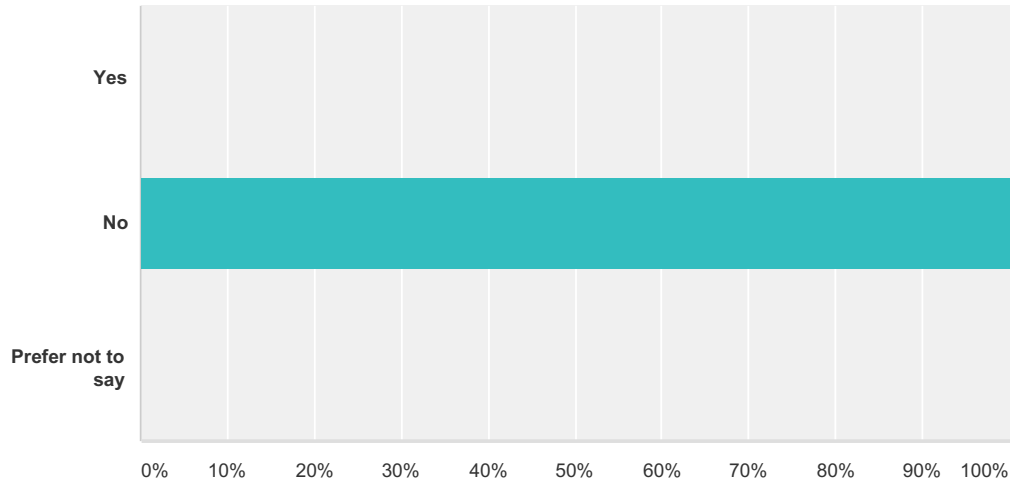

Q4 Do you consider your own gender identity to be different from that associated with your sex as registered at birth?

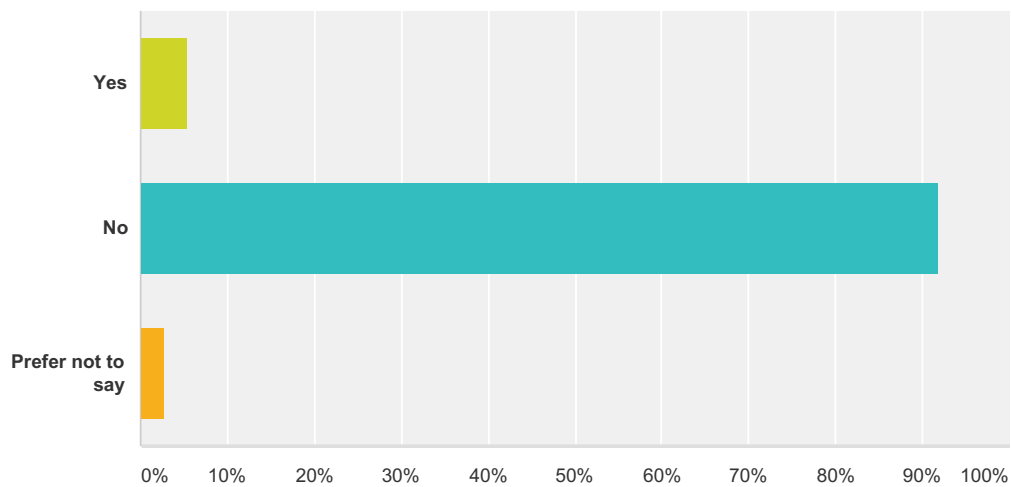

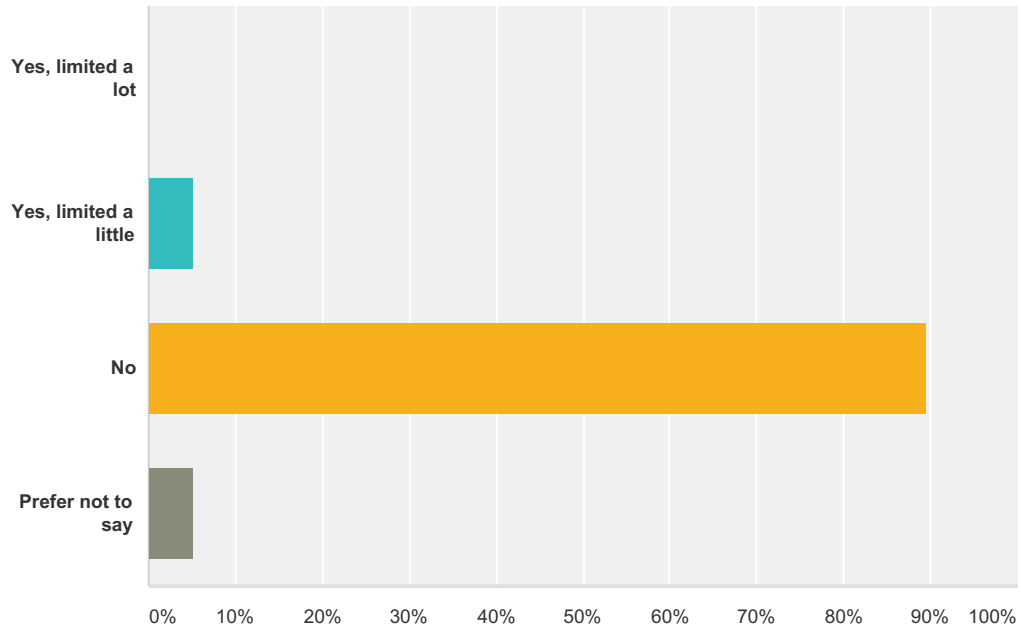

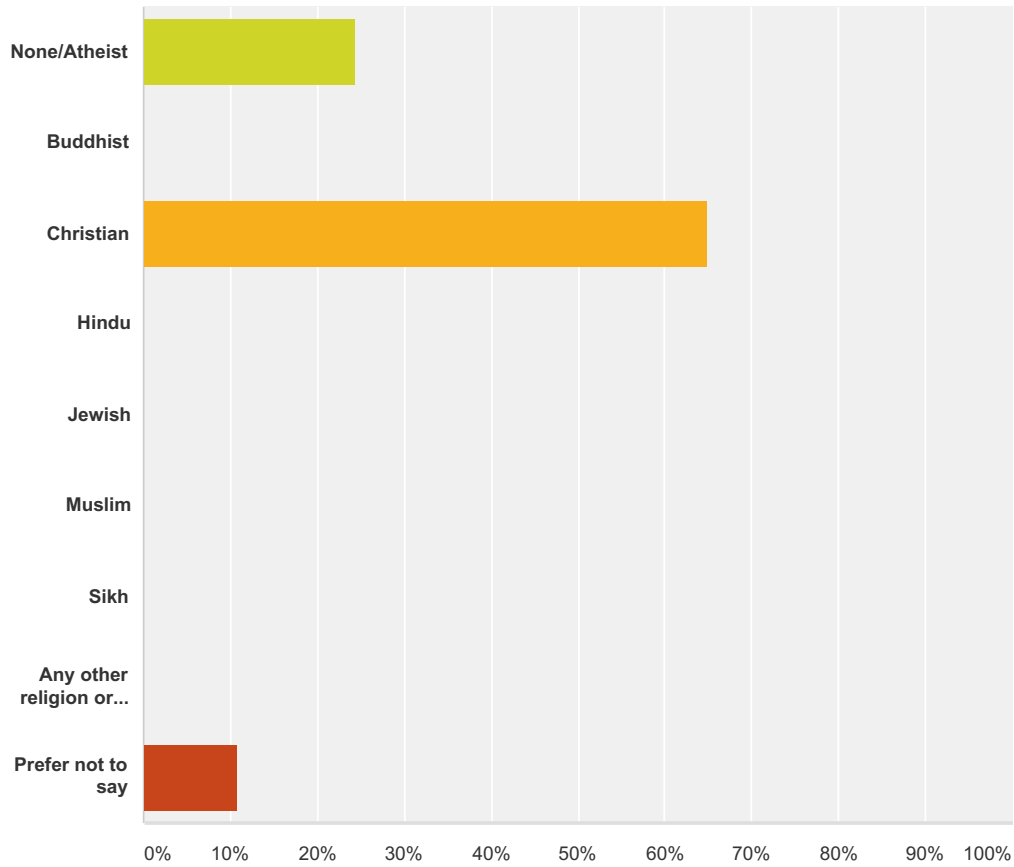

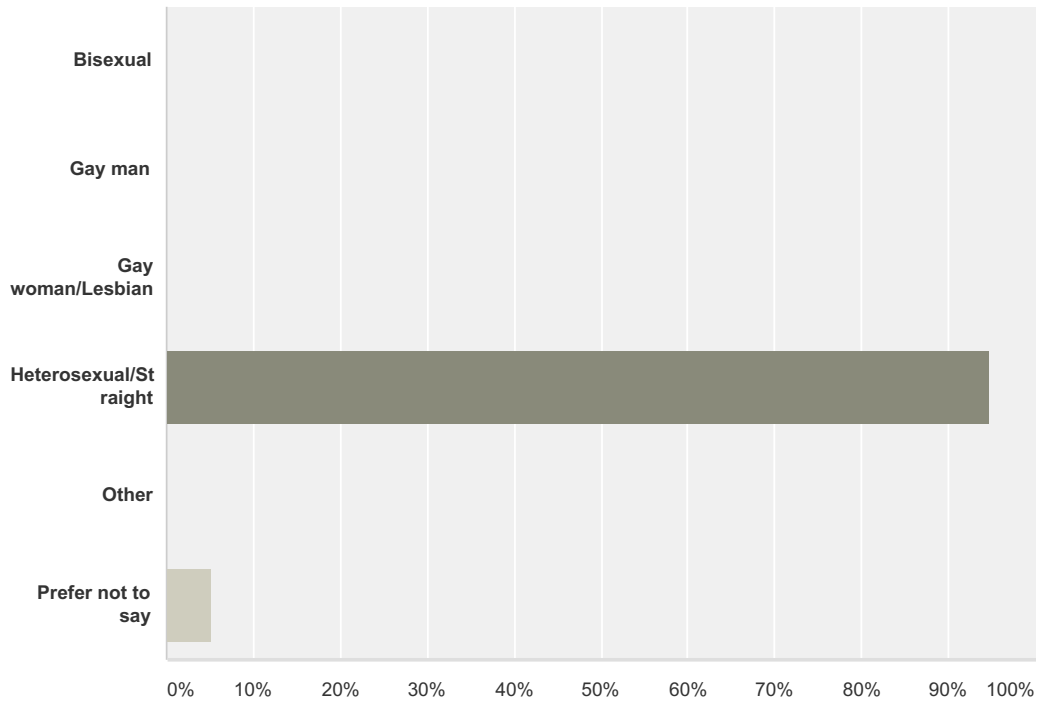

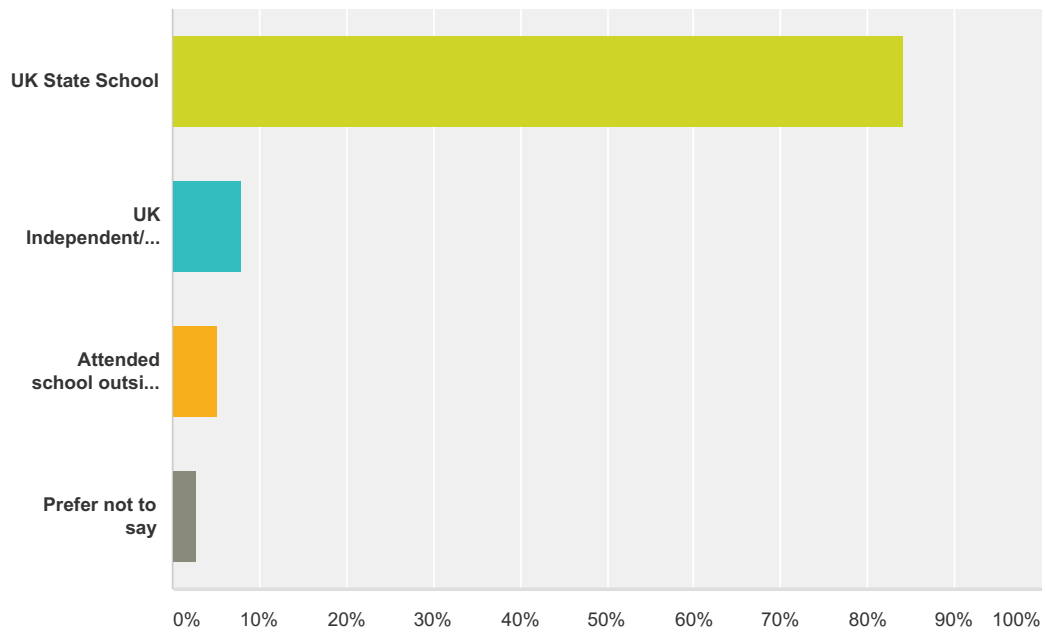

Q10 1. Did you mainly attend a state or fee paying school between the ages 11 – 18?

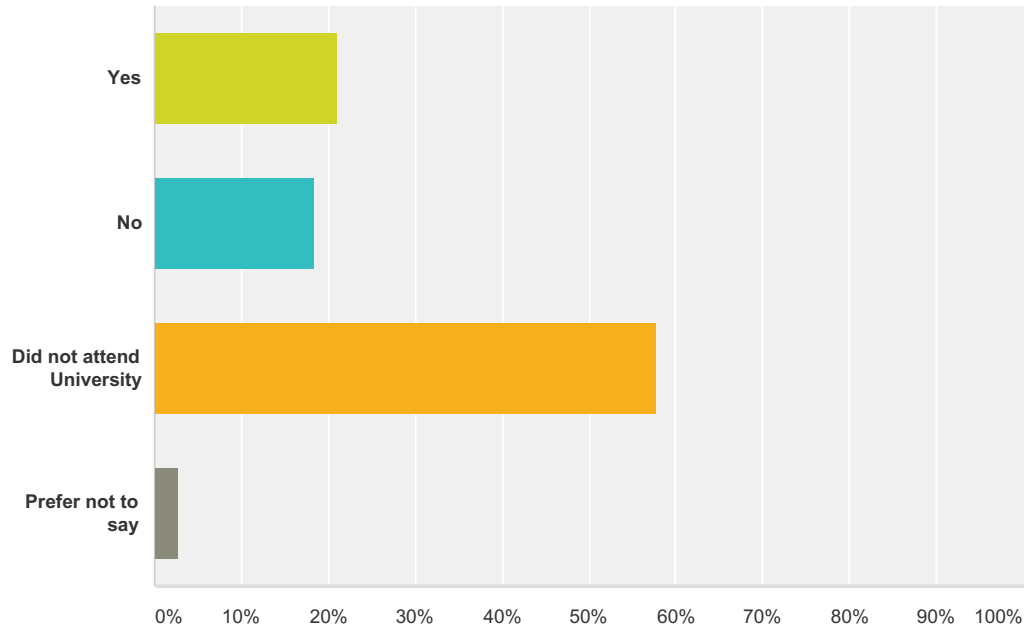

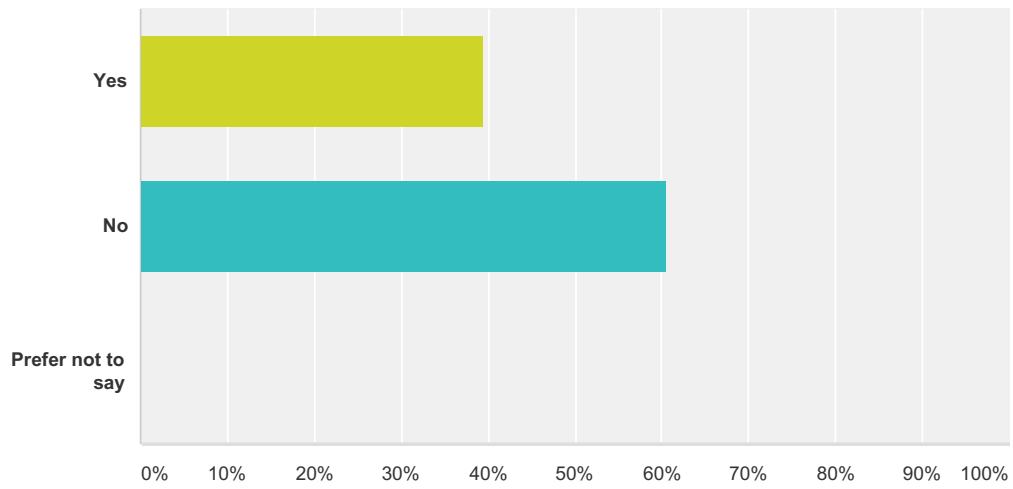

Q12 Are you a primary carer for a child or children under 18?

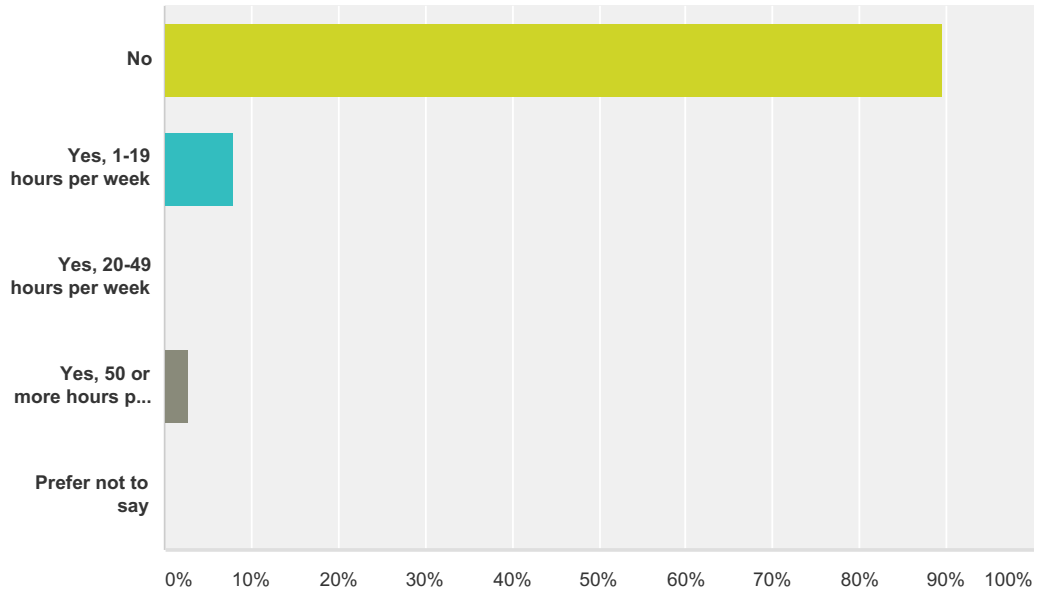
